the Virginia Board of Education Excellence Award since 2014, and was named a National Blue Ribbon School by the U. S. Department of Education in 2014. The GLE E2 program offers the school community on site before/after school child care, as well as a variety of 6 - 12 week enrichment classes each semester. GLE embraces 21st century technology skills for all students with grade 3, 4, and 5 students having 1-1 Chromebooks, while lower grade classrooms have six or more Chromebooks/Desktops, supplemented with liberal access to two computer labs and two laptop carts.



HARDING AVENUE

Harding Avenue Elementary, located in downtown Blacksburg, is a unique school built in the early 1970's with an open school format. Open schools have few interior walls where the design creates opportunities for an excellent collaborative learning environment. HAE maintains a high level of academic excellence and received the 2017 Board of Education Distinguished Achievement Award. 21st century technology skills are a priority at Harding Avenue and currently students in grades 3-5 participate in the 1-1 Chromebook initiative as part of their instructional program. The close proximity to Virginia Tech allows HAE students to benefit from the support of college professors and students who tutor, volunteer, and run clubs. HAE offers many after school clubs including Chess, Running, Knitting, Lego League, French, German, and Math Club. The LINK is Harding Avenue's on-site before and after-school program. HAE lives up to their motto "Where Each Child Matters."







KIPPS ELEMENTARY

Kipps Elementary School staff, students, parents, and community members emphasize the importance of school and community. They create a climate for learning, demonstrate a commitment to character, and implement a cohesive curriculum. Students are encouraged to make responsible choices, respect diversity, and develop necessary skills in a supportive and welcoming environment. Kipps maintains a high level of academic excellence and is fully accredited. Kipps received the 2016-2017 VA Index of Performance Board of Education Excellence Award. Twenty-first century technology skills are a priority and students in fourth and fifth grades participate in the 1:1 Chromebook initiative during their instructional day. Kipps Elementary provides many extracurricular clubs including Chess Club, French Club, German Club, Science Club, 4H Club, Chinese School, Virginia Tech College Mentors, Running Roos, Recorder Club, Orff Ensembles, and Three O'clock Band. The Three O'clock Band competed in the Music in the Parks competition in Williamsburg, VA and received first place in the Percussion Ensemble category, received a superior rating, and received the highest score in the competition, beating twenty-five high schools from across the east coast.

MARGARET BEEKS

Margaret Beeks Elementary was the first elementary school to implement the one to one eLearning initiative. Fifth grade students at Margaret Beeks Elementary were provided a Chromebook for use in school and at home. The purpose of this initiative was to ease the transition to 6th grade where students were already participating in a one to one program. Nearly all classroom teachers throughout the school were able to be attend training on Google Apps for Education, now known as GSuite. Students began learning how to become a digital citizen and student in the 21st century classroom. We look forward to this year as we expand our program down to third grade.
